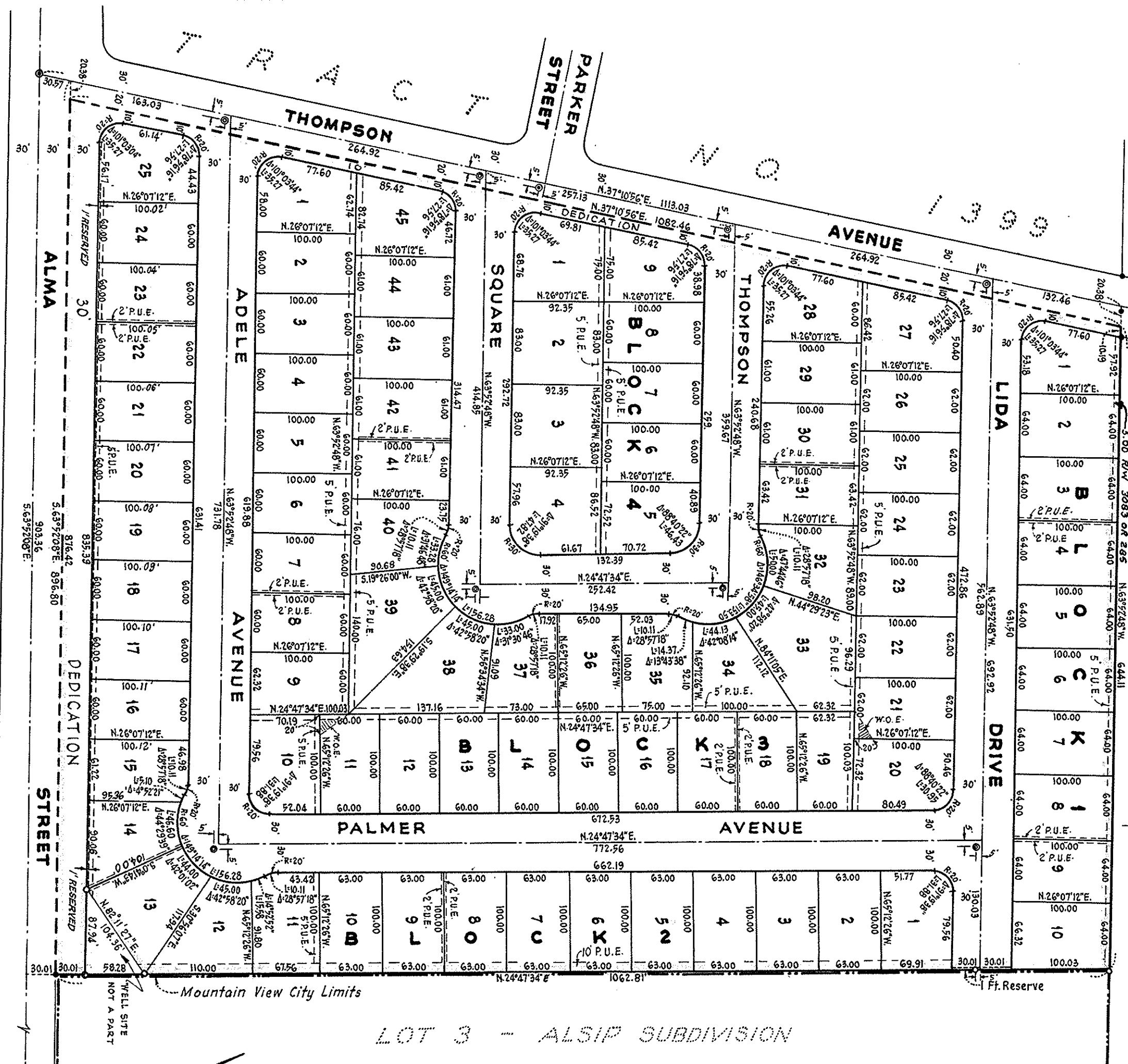

OWNERS' CERTIFICATE

We hereby certify that we are the owners of or have some right, title or interest in and to the real property included within the subdivision shown on this map, that we are the only persons whose consent is necessary to pass a clear title hereto and hereby consent to the making of said map and subdivision and hereby offer for dedication to public use all streets and portions of streets as shown on said map within said subdivision.

We also hereby dedicate for public use easements for public utilities under, on or over those certain strips of land lying between lot lines and adjacent dotted lines and each designated "Public Utility Easement" and Anchor Easements, 2x30' centered on lot lines and designated "A.E." We also dedicate the Overhead Easements as shown. We also hereby reserve portion of the street dedication, a strip of land one foot in width across the southeasterly termination of LIDA DRIVE designated "1 Ft. Reserve" until additional land adjoining such reserve is accepted for street purposes, at which time this reservation shall terminate and be of no further effect.
