- ALL BEARINGS AND DISTANCES TO BEARING TREES MARKED THIS
SURVEY ARE TO A BRASS DISC LS 4805 UNLESS NOTED.
- A THOROUGH SEARCH WAS MADE AT EACH STANDARD CORNER AND CLOSING
CORNER LOCATION ALONG THE TOWNSHIP LINE FROM THE S1/4 S32 TO THE
FOUND MONUMENT AT THE STANDARD CORNER S35T336. THE AREA HAS
BEEN BADLY BURNED OVER THE YEARS AND HEAVILY LOGGED IN SOME AREAS.
NO ORIGINAL BEARING TREES OR REMAINS THEREOF COULD BE FOUND AND
THERE WAS NO CONSISTENCY WITH TOPOGRAPHIC CALLS. THEREFORE,
SINGLE PROPORTION WAS USED TO POSITION CORNERS ALONG THE TOWNSHIP
LINE.
